We hope that you are all staying safe and healthy during these challenging times. The COVID-19 pandemic has personally affected all of our daily lives and routines. Unfortunately, due to social distancing requirements, KCC had to cancel all scheduled activities and close on March 13, 2020.

Fortunately, Northwest Senior Disabilities continues to prepare senior meals at the Center allowing the Meals on Wheels program to continue meal delivery to vulnerable and needy seniors throughout South County and beyond.

Kiawanda Community Center is a community-centered, self-supporting, not-for-profit organization. Our income is generated through space rentals including health and fitness activities, community programs, meetings and private events. We have also been fortunate to receive many donations from our generous community members.

However, as a result of our closing to adhere to social distancing requirements, we need your help now to meet basic financial obligations in keeping our building viable for future reopening. The Board has taken aggressive steps to reduce costs and has also applied for CARES Act loans/

grants. Recently we were awarded a small grant from the Payroll Protection Program, allowing us to extend the part time employment of our only employee for a few months. We understand that many organizations are reaching out for support during this crisis. Please consider supporting Kiawanda Community Center. Your generosity will help to ensure KCC's ability to reopen and provide valuable community services as soon as social distancing requirements are lifted.
